Vinidex PE on Par with Sanctuary Cove

Sanctuary Cove Golf and Country Club is a world-class golf course located on Hope Island in the Gold Coast, QLD. The club recently upgraded irrigation systems on the members only Pines golf course with Vinidex purple co-extruded PE100 and Rural Plus® pipes to ensure reliability and performance across the state-of-the-art facility.

The club's prestigious Pines course provides exclusive members-only access to some of Australia's most elite golfers. Set on the idyllic Queensland coastline, it requires superior, reliable materials and systems to uphold the best standards of service and Vinidex was excited to supply to the iconic and world-class golf course. The recent irrigation upgrade was no exception, with a quality recycled water pipeline required to keep the golf greens impeccably maintained. The pipeline would also need to deliver a greater output than the previous system.

Installed by Total Eden and supported by Vinidex employee Adam Bridges (Territory Manager), the supplied 20,000m of Vinidex purple co-extruded PE100 pipe offers the reliability needed to uphold the high standards at Sanctuary Cove. The damage resistance, flexibility and high impact strength of PE combined with our strong relationship with Total Eden ensured that installation was easy. The product is also clearly identified by the purple outer jacket, indicating that recycled water is in use, in compliance with AS/NZS 4130.

It is not the first time Vinidex has supplied a project on Hope Island as noted in the Christmas 1989 edition of the former Vinidex company newsletter 'The Piper'. Over 13,000m of Vinyl Iron PVC-U was used in 1989 for water supply. At the time, the area was undergoing substantial earthworks and construction as a result of a major tourism boom in the 80's.
