

THINK AID PROJECT INAUGURAL INDUSTRY CHARITY EVENT

In August, Vinidex attended the Think Water Conference, which was held in Fiji. The location is voted on by members each year, and by holding the event in Fiji there was the opportunity to support local communities, by creating the 'Think Aid Project'.

Over 50 Think Water members, partners, kids and suppliers worked at two local schools to provide better services. Vinidex, with Philmac and Marley NZ, donated pipe, fittings, guttering and water tanks.

Vinidex employees Adam Tindal and John Pivac helped at 'Ratu Illiasi', a school with 110 students. The improvements will provide fresh drinking water to the children and also more reliable services to their toilet block, which in times of drought could not be used previously due to inconsistent water supply.

Vinidex also supplied 100 small footballs to the students at the beginning of the day. A teacher mentioned that almost all of the children had never

owned their own ball, and it was very special that they would be able to take it home to their families. Such a simple gift would be cherished for a very long time.

John Pivac said "It was for Adam and I, a very humbling day and really reinforced just how lucky we really are here in Australia".
